ONLINE COURSE! Memoir full-manuscript consultation with Nancy Owen Nelson: ***REGISTER ANYTIME.*** This course is available for 3 months from the time that you register so you can go at your own pace. The class can be either online, face-to-face, or a combination. The class \$150 for members. \$200 for nonmembers (join as a member for one year). This is for writers who have a full or almost complete manuscript (up to 200 pages) and want to work with a published author on a holistic view of her/his work. (Longer manuscripts will be negotiated). We may read segments from well-known memoir writers and discuss what shapes the personal story into art. Your instructor will provide constructive feedback on your work. Writers should feel at ease with MS Word and the editing mode. It will be important to pace the interactions so that the work can be completed in the four-month period. You can expect an interaction with the instructor for two hours a week. Nancy Owen Nelson has published poetry and creative nonfiction as well as articles in several academic journals and anthologies. She was editor and/or co-editor of three academic books. She earned her B.A. in French and English at Birmingham-Southern College and her M.A. and PhD in English at Auburn University. She taught composition and literature at Auburn University, Augustana College, Albion College, and Henry Ford College. She also served as Assistant Director of the Hassayampa Institute for Creative Writing at Yavapai College, Prescott, AZ. Her memoir, *Searching for Nannie B.: Three Generations of Southern Women*, was recently published by The Ardent Writer Press. She is seeking publication for a second memoir, *Divine Aphasia*.
